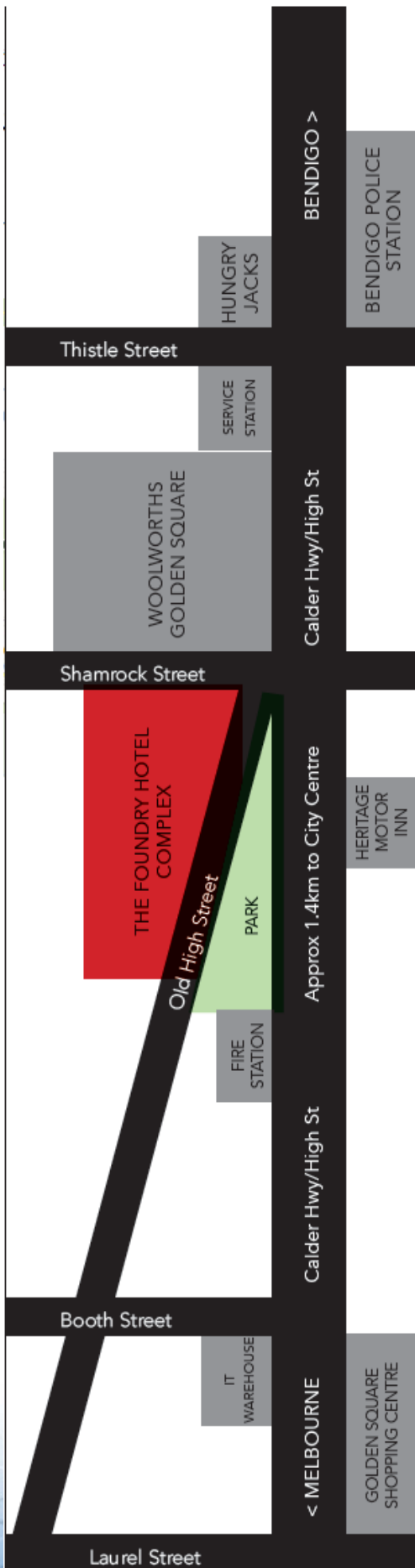
- ◆ Jeff Rigby – Jeff is the MD of Coliban Water and also the current chair of the WSAA OHS Network
